Kessler	30 <b>Divine Liturgy</b> 9:30 am	<p><b>A Selection of Clergy Disciplines According to the Canons of the Church</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The clergy are strictly to observe the teachings of The Church, regarding Christ, the Sacred Scriptures and Holy Traditions (Ephesus, c. 6, 7; Trullo, c. 1; Carthage, c. 2).</li> <li>The clergy are under the complete authority of the diocesan hierarch, without whose blessing they cannot function and to whom they must show proper respect (Laodicea, c. 57; Holy Apostles, c.31, 39, 55; Carthage, c. 10).</li> <li>The clergy are to show respect and concern for other members of the clergy (Holy Apostles, c. 56, 59).</li> <li>The duty of the priest is to instruct the faithful in the way of godliness (Holy Apostles, c. 58).</li> <li>Clergy are to be examples to the flock through prayer and fasting as prescribed by the Church (Carthage, c. 41; Holy Apostles, c. 69).</li> <li>Clergy should not abstain from the Eucharist (Trullo, c. 80; Holy Apostles, c. 8).</li> </ol>
